

Bidding Blurb

When bidding on a prevailing wage project it's highly recommended to include verbiage of where the wage rates in the bid are from. This could be there are a mix of rates.

Blurb example:

The rates in this bid are based on federal Wage Determination RI20240001 located in Bristol County, Rhode Island and is stated as a building wage determination project.

If project information changes an updated bid with updated wage rates will need to be submitted.

This blurb example shows the type of construction project, where it's located, and in what state. It also states to the client that if information has changed then the bid will also. This is important as it helps protect the project's profit margin.

This blurb can also include the wage rate information for projects that have more than one set of prevailing wages rates for that particular project. The important information is that the blurb contain the wage information so that down the road a person can follow where you pulled the wage rates from to calculate the labor costs.
